Perinatal FGM Clinic	Our midwife-led FGM service includes both antenatal and postnatal FGM clinics. The aim of our service is to improve the perinatal experience and outcome for both mother and baby, whilst providing health information/advice and protecting children. An assessment of the extent of the FGM is offered, following which an individualised plan of care is made with the woman. Leeds Teaching Hospitals NHS Trust perinatal FGM clinic has been running since 2008. We see over 150 perinatal women a year and offer assessments, care planning, de-infibrillation and referrals for counselling etc. Our gynaecology consultant sees non-perinatal women. Referrals via midwives/GPS. Leeds. The antenatal clinic is held at St James's Hospital on Wednesday mornings. The postnatal clinic is held at St James's Hospital on Tuesday afternoons.	
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
